From Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning to Cybersecurity and support for the war fighter, the people that make up these technology companies are actively involved in national security. Along with these "pointy edge of the sword companies" are support industries in staffing, construction, finance, and legal which serve to support the infrastructure, financial, and legal needs of this community.

Lt. Gen. Haugh Confirmed

The U.S. Senate voted to confirm President Joseph R. Biden, Jr.'s nomination of U.S. Air Force Lt. Gen. Timothy D. Haugh to the rank of General and to assume the duties as the Commander, U.S. Cyber Command (CYBERCOM), Director, National Security Agency (NSA)/Chief, Central Security Service (CSS). Lt. Gen. Haugh is scheduled to assume his new role following a change-of-command ceremony planned for early 2024.

2023 Cybersecurity Year in Review

The National Security Agency (NSA) published its 2023 Cybersecurity Year in Review today to share its recent cybersecurity successes and how it is working with partners to deliver on cybersecurity advances that enhance national security. This year's report highlights NSA's work with U.S government partners, foreign partners, and the Defense Industrial Base.

President signs NDAA into Law

The Senate voted 87-13 to pass the FY 2024 NDAA, which cleared the House in a 310-118 vote. The NDAA reflects a 3 percent hike in the country's total national security budget and a 5.2 percent pay increase for service personnel, according to the report. The defense policy measure authorizes appropriations for the departments of Defense and State, Department of Energy's national security initiatives and the Intelligence Community.

L3 Harris to Put off M&A Activities

Christopher Kubasik, chair and CEO of L3Harris Technologies (NYSE: LHX), said the company plans to discontinue its merger and acquisition activity for the "foreseeable future" to strengthen its balance sheet and return all excess capital to shareholders. The company's capital deployment priorities between 2024 and 2026 include research and development investments and efforts to pay down debt to reach a leverage of 3.0x.

New Cryptologic Center in Colorado

The NSA has broken ground on a Joint Cryptologic Center at Buckley Space Force Base in Aurora, Colorado. The building will contain training and administrative facilities for NSA Colorado Service Cryptologic Elements and the new Rocky Mountain Learning Center. The new learning center aims to address the comprehensive training demands of NSAC personnel, who support national missions and priorities worldwide.

Coker Confirmed

Harry Coker, a former senior executive at the CIA and the National Security Agency, has received confirmation from the Senate to serve as the nation's second permanent national cyber director. He will lead the Office of the National Cyber Director and advise the president on developing policies and strategies for strengthening the U.S. cybersecurity defense posture.

Defense Technology






Historical TEV/TTM EBITDA Multiples


